1. Breakout of the \$5.8 million supplemental at a level 3 – who are we paying (the major amounts). Unfit to proceed costs – how much per hour for medical treatment? (Request made to the Governor's Office).
2. (PROVIDED) Copy of the IT strategic plan (Request made to the Judiciary).
3. (PROVIDED) An analysis by the Judiciary of their IT deployment plan with a time line and costs of each major task. Also ask the state CIO to attend the next meeting. (Request made to the Judiciary).
4. (PROVIDED) A chart of accounts that lists the type of items charged to personal services and operating costs (for Rep Sinrud only). (Request made to the LFD).
5. A chart that lists three things: (1) the number of computers currently on-line and the number that will be on-line after Full Court is fully deployed; (2) the number of people using Full Court and the number expected to be using it when fully deployed; and (3) the number of people that currently has DOA connectivity and the number expected in the future. (Request made to the Judiciary).
