


**THE PROPOSED DEADMAN'S BASIN SUPPLY CANAL
REHABILITATION PROJECT**

The Deadman's Basin Water Project, located in Wheatland and Golden Valley Counties, is owned by the DNRC and operated by the Deadman's Basin Water Users Association. The Project comprises a 76,900 acre-feet, off-stream reservoir; one 11.5-mile, 600-cfs supply canal; and two delivery canals that total 12.5 miles in length. Due to deterioration from age, design deficiencies, and insufficient repairs, the supply canal now requires substantial rehabilitation. The DNRC is requesting a grant of \$100,000 and a loan of \$50,000 as the first step in a three-phase process that will eliminate hazardous conditions and conserve water for beneficial use to landowners and the general public.
