

1. Page 6, line 9.

Following: section (2)

Insert: “ (3)(a) The department of fish, wildlife and parks, for the purpose of selling the Jocko Fish Hatchery to the Confederated Salish and Kootenai Tribes and in exchange for constructing and improving the fish hatchery at the Rose Creek Hatchery, may waive, in whole or in part, the requirements pertaining to:

- (i) public bids for land disposal in 87-1-209(3); and
- (ii) real property trust fund in 87-1-601.

(b) The waiver pursuant to subsection (3)(a) may be exercised only under the circumstances described above. The waiver also does not affect the department’s requirement to obtain full market value pursuant to Art. X, Section 11 of the Montana Constitution.

Explanation: The first item in this amendment increases the Department of Fish, Wildlife and Parks' appropriation for spending authority at the Rose Creek Hatchery. The second item in this amendment corrects the funding source designation for monies that will be used for the project.
