- Groundwater remediation for chemical spills
- Cost recovery

### Our Accomplishments

- **CECRA and LUST Cost Recovery**
  - State Superfund Recovery 7/03 - 12/04 = \$866,464
  - Tank Release Recovery 7/03 - 12/04 = \$40,375
- **Closing Petroleum Releases**
  - Closed 94 releases between 7/03 - 12/04
- **State Superfund Listings and Closures**
  - Listed 6 facilities to State Superfund Priority List
  - Closed 2 sites under Voluntary Cleanup and Redevelopment Act





**Major Decision Packages**

- Proposing to fund LUST Trust grant match from the Petroleum Tank Release Compensation Fund instead of Hazardous Waste CERCLA
- Requesting \$2 million of state special revenue each year of the biennium to spend bond proceeds
- Proposing \$2 million one-time only, restricted general fund appropriation for investigation and feasibility study at Kalispell Pole and Timber, Reliance Refinery and Yale Oil facilities
