Insert: "proof that the victim is a resident of this state and"

4. Page 5, line 24.
Insert: "NEW SECTION. Section 8. State and local government immunity from suit. The department, any other state agency, and any local government agency are immune from civil suit for their actions under [sections 1 through 6]."
Insert: "NEW SECTION. Section 9. Two-thirds vote required. Because [section 8] limits governmental liability, Article II, section 18, of the Montana constitution requires a vote of two-thirds of the members of each house of the legislature for passage. If [this act] is not approved by at least two-thirds of the members of each house of the legislature, then [section 8] is void."
