Current Information as of January 28th. 2005
Regarding numbers of Native Americans within the Corrections
system, where crimes committed and where sentenced.

Please find attached the information as requested.

- The shaded area at the top of the page indicates that County judgments have not been entered into the Dept. of Corrections system yet as they have not been received by the appropriate counties. There is, a total of 15 for females and 46 for males for a grand total of 61. These figures are **not** included at the bottom of the page totals.
- In the top left hand column, which, reads Out of State County, Montana has agreed to hold or supervise these offenders through Interstate Compact. These figures are included in the bottom of the page totals.
- The number of Native American females within the Department of Corrections system is 352. There are a total of 615 judgments for the female offenders.
- A judgment is one or more offenses.
- The number of Native American males within the Department of Corrections system is 1243. There are a total of 2541 judgments for the male offenders.
- The total number of Native American offenders (male and female) within the Department of Corrections system is 1595. There are a total of 3156 judgments for the male and female offenders.
- Native American youth represent 12%-18% of arrests, referrals to juvenile court, secure detention, petition filings, delinquent findings, probation placement, and secure confinement, and in the juvenile corrections systems, ranging 20% at the Pine Hills Youth Correctional Facility for boys and up to 50% at the Riverside Youth Correctional Facility for girls.
