**Centennial Rededication of T.F. Meagher Statue**

*Members of this distinguished body, I rise today... near the eve of the month of Saint Patrick... praying the gracious support of my colleagues in both Houses, to present a Special Order acknowledging the 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Thomas Francis Meagher statue which graces the front of our great Montana Capitol Building.*

*On the 5<sup>th</sup> of July, 2005, this hallmark statue that the citizens of our State and its many visitors have enjoyed for a century will be the subject of a Centennial Celebration.*

*Accordingly, I ask the august bodies of the Senate and the House of Representatives to issue the following order:*

**SPECIAL ORDER**

*The House of Representatives and the Senate of the State of Montana, effective the 17<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2005, hereby encourage and give our recognition and support to the Centennial Celebration of the setting of and recent restoration of the Thomas Francis Meagher statue.*

*We recognize the honor due this Irish patriot, American Civil War General, and First Secretary of the Montana Territory and who became the Acting Territorial Governor from September 1865 to July 1867, for his contributions to the cause of freedom and prosperity for the people of this State. We further order and declare that this July 5, 2005, shall be known as the Thomas Francis Meagher Day in the State of Montana.*
