ASSUMPTIONS:

1. Under the proposed legislation, judges would be permitted to order an offender on probation to participate in a day reporting program
2. This bill permits the Department of Corrections to contract with private, nonprofit Montana corporations to operate the day reporting program in conjunction with a prerelease program.
3. Because this bill uses permissive language and doesn't obligate the department to operate a day reporting program there would be no fiscal impact.
