(3) A provider has an obligation to:

(a) properly use and maintain products and equipment used in a provided sport or recreational opportunity;

(b) provide services in a manner that is consistent with industry standards for the sport or recreational opportunity; and

(c) inform a participant of any physical requirements necessary to participate in the sport or recreational opportunity."

(3) inform a provider of a sport or recreational opportunity of any physical limitations of the participant that affect the participant's ability to meet physical requirements that the provider informed the participant are necessary for the sport or recreational opportunity."
