Insert: "(4) If a voting system records an overvote on a ballot, the ballot must be set aside and examined by a counting board of election judges. If all of the election judges on the counting board agree that the system's interpretation of an overvote was incorrect because of a stray mark on the ballot and that there is one vote that may be clearly counted as cast according to instructions, then the vote must be counted."
