

delegate Permanency Planning Hearings to the Foster Care Review Committee, the Court would be apprised of the Committee's recommendations in the form of a report. The Court must issue a finding as to whether DPHHS has made reasonable efforts to finalize the permanency plan for a child; thus if there is material disagreement from one of the parties, the Court has the discretion to conduct a full hearing or in the alternative issue its order based on the Foster Care Review Committee's review of the permanency plan.
