2005 Code Commissioner Bill Summary

The Code Commissioner bill summary does not reflect changes made to render language gender neutral, to conform existing language to current style, or to delete certain obsolete language.

- Section 1 1-1-516. In (1) and (2) substituted "Korean war veterans' memorial" for "Korean veterans' memorial" for clarification and consistent use of terminology.
- Section 2 2-2-106. In (1)(a) substituted "state officer or holdover senator" for "elected official or department director" for clarity and to use defined term.
- Section 3 2-15-1821. Reoutlined (4) to clarify requirements for appointing members to the coal board.
- Section 4 2-15-1822. Reoutlined (3) to clarify requirements for appointing members to the hard-rock mining impact board.
- Section 5 2-18-1204. At end of (2) deleted "including those funds subject to transfer under the provisions of section 6, Chapter 524, Laws of 1995" to remove obsolete reference.
- Section 6 3-10-301. In (1)(f) substituted "an order of a conservation district" for "an order of a district" for clarity.
- Section 7 5-7-112. Inserted reference to 5-7-103 to include reference that was omitted when section was enacted by Ch. 572, L. 2003.
- Section 8 7-1-2111. Inserted (2)(j) referring to use of 45% of contract sales price of gross proceeds of coal in the county in determining taxable valuation of the county pursuant to 15-23-703 to insert omitted reference.
- Section 9 7-2-2422. Throughout section substituted references to clerk or clerks of district court for references to clerk or clerks to clarify language from R.C.M.
- Section 10 7-2-2424. In two places substituted references to clerk or clerks of district court for references to clerk or clerks to clarify language from R.C.M.
- Section 11 7-3-173. At end of (2)(a) deleted "as provided in section 2, Chapter 70, Laws of 1977" to remove obsolete reference.

- Section 23 17-2-131. At beginning of second sentence deleted "Funds appropriated under section 2, Chapter 686, Laws of 1989, and" to remove obsolete reference.
- Section 24 17-5-507. In third sentence of (1) after "15-70-204" deleted "enacted by section 3, Chapter 369, Laws of 1969, as amended by section 1, Chapter 202, and by section 2, Chapter 204, Laws of 1971, and by section 90, Chapter 516, Laws of 1973, or by any subsequent enactment" to remove obsolete references.

- Section 26 20-3-351. In (1)(a) after "building is located" deleted "or, if there is more than one elementary district in which high school buildings are located, the trustees of the elementary district designated by the high school boundary commission" to reflect elimination of high school boundary commissions by Ch. 219, L. 1997.
- Section 27 20-9-141. In (1)(b)(v) substituted "20-9-630" for "section 244, Chapter 574, Laws of 2001" to correct reference to section enacted in 2001 but not codified until 2003.

- Section 45 33-22-140. In definition of COBRA continuation provision in (b) substituted "29 U.S.C. 1001, et seq." for "Public Law 93-406" to update citation to federal law.
- Section 46 37-10-304. In (1)(a) substituted "board of optometry" for "board of optometrists" to reflect change to board's name made by Ch. 121, L. 1993.
- Section 47 39-11-201. In (1) substituted "grant review committee" for "loan review committee" to correct erroneous name of committee included in section when enacted by Ch. 567, L. 2003.

20 **Section 1.** Section 1-1-516, MCA, is amended to read:

21 **"1-1-516. State Korean war veterans' memorial -- Butte.** (1) The Korean war veterans' memorial
22 located in Stodden Park, Butte, Montana, dedicated to the men and women who served the United States in the
23 Republic of Korea, is an official state Korean war veterans' memorial.

24 (2) The department of commerce and the department of transportation are directed to reference the
25 location of a state Korean war veterans' memorial on official state maps."

27 **Section 2.** Section 2-2-106, MCA, is amended to read:

28 **"2-2-106. Disclosure.** (1) (a) Prior to December 15 of each even-numbered year, each ~~elected official~~
29 ~~or department director~~ state officer or holdover senator shall file with the commissioner of political practices a
