Insert: "NEW SECTION. Section 3. Supreme court candidates -- limits on independent expenditures. (1) An incidental political committee may not make an independent expenditure in connection with a candidate for justice of the supreme court or a political committee that supports or opposes a candidate for justice of the supreme court in excess of \$1,300 for each election in a campaign.

(2) For purposes of this section, "independent expenditure" means an expenditure for communications expressly advocating the success or defeat of a candidate that is not made with the cooperation or prior consent of or in consultation with or at the request or suggestion of a candidate or political committee or an agent of a candidate or political committee."

Insert: "NEW SECTION. Section 4. {standard} Codification instruction. [Section 3] is intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 13, chapter 37, part 2, and the provisions of Title 13, chapter 37, part 2, apply to [section 3]."
