

Developmental Disabilities Program

"Developmental disability" means a disability that is attributable to mental retardation, cerebral palsy, epilepsy, or any other neurologically disabling condition closely related to mental retardation and that requires treatment similar to that required by mentally retarded individuals. A developmental disability is a disability that originated before the individual attained age 18, that has continued or can be expected to continue indefinitely, and that results in the person having a substantial disability.

- 4006 individuals currently served in a community-based system
 - 1879 children under the age 18
 - 2127 adults
- 300 individuals are on a waiting list who have no services
- 800 are receiving some services, but are in need of other services
- The cost of services depends on the significance of the disability and the type and amount of supports they will need
 - **average** cost is \$30,000 per year
 - **range** from \$1,000 - \$90,000

Types of Services

- Work and other day services
 - Facility-based work programs
 - Supported employment / job placement
 - Senior programs
- Community living / residential services
 - Community homes for children, adults, seniors, and those with intensive needs
 - Supported living services
- Home-based services to families
 - Early intervention services / Part C – birth to age 3
 - Family education and support
 - Intensive needs services
- Other Support services
 - Case management
 - Adaptive equipment
 - Evaluation and diagnosis services
