In 2003 and 2004.

- December 17 – 19, 2002 “Seabiscut” scout – about 6 people looked over sites for 4-5 hours on December 12, and two-person crew sketched possible sites for next two days.
- January 21-24, 2003 Marlboro Clothing – Still photo shoot, advertising Marlboro clothing – ‘Marlboro Man’ plus crew of about six, four 8-hour days.
- March, 2003 Display “buildings” for the Montana movie promotion were repaired and made ready for the Governor’s Tourism Conference and the Los Angeles Film Festival.
- June 23, 2003 BBC Documentary – 2-3 hours – filmed mostly in Virginia City.
- June 26, 2003 H.S. Trask Shoes – Still photo shoot for advertising, about 8 hours, crew of about four people including H.S. Trask himself, who was very pleased with the location.
- March 23, 2004 Display “buildings” for Montana movie promotion repaired and boxed for shipment to the Los Angeles Film Festival.
- June 16, 2004 “King of Adventure” Taiwan Documentary - about 8 hours. The crew filmed most of the day, and also wished to film on their own in the evening light. “King of Adventure” is a very popular TV show in Taiwan.
- June 28, 2004 “Masa Oiami” Israel Travelogue, 3 ½ hours. Numerous shots taken mostly in Virginia City.
- July 23, 2004 Evelyn Cameron – PBS Documentary – 5 hours. The crew numbered about six, plus about eight actors and “extras” and the scenes also featured horses.
- August 1, 2004 Bozeman TV Station made a three-minute news “spot” on restoration work at Content’s Corner, VC history, and an interview with Evelyn Johnson. Filming took about three hours.
- October 26, 2004 History Channel filmed part of a “Save Our History” video series about Gold Rush Ghost towns.
- December, 2004 “Miracle at Sage Creek”, a family movie for Television, uses Commission props.
