A Large Vehicle Supplement Must Be Completed If:

- (a) The vehicle has a gross vehicle weight rating or gross combination weight rating of more than 10,000 lbs. (This would include farm vehicles).
- (b) The vehicle is designed to transport more than 8 people, including the driver.
- (c) The vehicle is used in the transportation of hazardous material in a quantity requiring placarding.

CARRIER NAME:

- (a) May be found on single state registration form (SSRS) if motor carrier operates for-hire in interstate commerce.
- (b) May be found on the vehicle registration if motor vehicle is not leased to a company.
- (c) May be found on side of vehicle
- (d) May be found on shipping or insurance documents.
- (e) May be found on driver's record of duty status (log book).


GROSS VEHICLE WEIGHT RATING (GVWR):
