The Effectiveness of Parent-Taught Driver Education	
<i>A survey conducted by the University of Colorado, Colorado Springs</i>	
<p>According to Insurance Company Statistics, out of every 100 teen drivers:</p> <p>37 will be ticketed for speeding</p> <p>28 will be involved in accidents</p> <p>13 will be injured in an automobile crash</p> <p>4 will be ticketed for driving under the influence of alcohol or drugs</p> <p>1 will be killed in an automobile crash</p>	<p>According to the UCCS survey, for every 100 parent-taught* teen drivers:</p> <p>8 were ticketed for speeding</p> <p>16 were involved in accidents</p> <p>6 were injured in automobile crash</p> <p>1 was ticketed for driving under the influence of alcohol or drugs</p> <p>There were <i>no fatalities</i></p>

Clearly, in all cases, the extra efforts of parents produced safer drivers. In each category, parent-taught teen drivers were less than half as likely as their peers to be involved in an unsafe act.
