2. Page 1, line 25.

**Insert:** "WHEREAS, a basic system of free quality public elementary and secondary schools intends to provide a quality education, which will promote the full development of a student's potential to think deliberatively and critically, to maintain a broad knowledge base, and to learn independently to the level of the student's ability; and  
WHEREAS, the goal of a quality education is to nurture democratic, productive, and responsible citizenry.

3. Page 2, line 27 through line 28.

**Strike:** "for" on line 27 through "students;" on line 28

**Insert:** "that promote the full development of a student's potential to deliberate and discern, to maintain a broad knowledge base, and to learn independently. These educational programs must meet the needs of the full spectrum of students, including but not limited to:  
(i) special needs students;  
(ii) students with disabilities;  
(iii) at-risk students; and  
(iv) gifted and talented students."

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
