## If you believe in evolution . . .

In the light of current science, evolution is no longer credible.

Evolution denies that God has anything to do with creation. Evolution says that chance and accident create improvements in animals and survival of the fittest causes the improved animals to live and the weaker animals to die. Evolution offers no mechanism other than chance and survival of the fittest to account for all of life. Pure chance (a series of unobserved accidents) is supposed to have produced and continually improved *all* plants and animals on earth. And at the same time, survival of the fittest is supposed to have killed the weaker ones and left the world to the strong ones. Chance creates and survival of the fittest destroys in evolution. So, in evolution chance is the sole mechanism for creating stronger animals and death is the sole mechanism for removing weak ones.

So, if you believe in evolution, then:

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- You believe that random chance created a non-physical code (a language) that is 3,000,000,000 letters long and inscribed it upon a molecule. This is the DNA molecule.

It has been said that the DNA molecule is equivalent to inscribing the Encyclopedia Britannica upon a molecule. However, in actual fact, this comparison is inaccurate. It is more accurate to say that it is equivalent to inscribing 20 Encyclopedias Britannicas upon a molecule ([click here](#) to see the basis for this argument).

These 3,000,000,000 letters are used to provide intricate instructions for combining particular atoms and molecules *in the proper sequence* to

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manufacture 100,000 specific human proteins.

If you are an evolutionist, you believe that not only the proteins, but also the *instructions* for the proteins were formed by chance. And you believe this even though each protein performs a different function that is intricately wedded to a particular requirement of the human body. All of these functions are complimentary and all of the 100,000 proteins that make them possible must be produced constantly and in the right proportions.

Additionally, 2000 enzymes must also be produced in exactly the right proportions, all of which must work in harmony.

Of course, no single protein is of any use at all by itself, but perhaps that fact is of no moment to you, if you are an evolutionist. Because if you are truly an evolutionist, there is no infinity of impossibilities that is sufficient to convince you that anything but accidents and survival of the fittest produced an almost infinite organization of atoms. In fact, even if the chances of *just the enzymes* occurring by chance were 1 in all of the atoms of the universe, a true evolutionist would not believe that anything but chance and survival of the fittest produced them.


If you believe in evolution, you believe that all of this occurred through chance mutations with nothing other than dying animals to shape inconceivable and irreducible complexities that are now common knowledge.

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- You believe that the death of inferior animals somehow directed the improvement of a species. You may believe this because you must believe it in order to retain a whisp of reason.

But you know that the deaths of inferior animals can do nothing to *create* superior changes. All death does is to *destroy* changes. You know that the death of inferior animals may in some cases, but certainly not all, destroy inferior changes. But it can do nothing to create superior changes. Only chance (according to evolution) can do that. So, if

Evolution leaves no room for God. "God directed" evolution is not evolution. It is a type of creationism.


- If you believe in evolution, you believe that somehow 10,000,000,000,000,000 individual neurological connections that perform the functions of the human brain randomly came together through a series of accidental mutations in just the right arrangement. This translates into the accidental manufacture of a hard-wired electrical network containing approximately the same number of organized connections as there are leaves on the trees in a forest that is half the size of the United States.<sup>1</sup> That is a forest approximately the size of Saudi Arabia, Iraq and Iran combined or the size of Continental Europe or twice the size of India.

This calculates into a rate of evolution of approximately 9.5 *perfected and installed* mutations every minute for 2,000,000,000 years with *each one fully integrated*, connected and *fully functional*. That is *one completed mutation every 7 seconds*.

It is simply ludicrous to argue that this was created by happenstance and the death of inferior animals.

- Inside of the cell, you believe that random mutations also produced a device that copies a precise segment of a DNA molecule for the express purpose of producing a particular protein. The segment is approximately 1/100,000th of the length of the DNA molecule. The copy bears no physical resemblance whatever to the molecule

that it will be used to manufacture. It is nothing but pure code, pure logic. And the logic is separate from the arrangement of the atoms that carry the code - like the information contained on this page is separate from the pixels on your computer screen. It is separate in the same way that a chemical formula written on 4 pages of an encyclopedia is separate from the type and the ink on the pages. The type and the ink of little relevance. It is the logic, the meaning conveyed by the ink that carries the substance, not the ink itself. This meaning and the logic and the structure of the code that conveys the meaning is non-physical and therefore not subject to mutation.

Inside the cell, a copy of the code is transferred to another device, which is operated through another encoded mechanism that reads the *meaning* of the code and then retrieves the necessary atoms and molecules described by the code and assembles them in the proper sequence to produce the protein molecule that the code describes. So we find one accidentally formed code reading another accidentally formed code to enable every cell in your body to constantly manufacture (molecule by molecule) all of the 100,000 different protein molecules that you need.

that there is *no* perceptable delay between the action and the perception of the action.

Some of these devices work for more than a century without stopping. All of this too occurred by random mutations. 
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Do you really believe that survival of the fittest and accidental change adequately explains what you observe?
