WHEREAS, Missoula County Public School District has three urban high schools and one rural high school, and

WHEREAS, two of the urban high schools are served by elementary districts that have schools outside of the Missoula County Public School District's Elementary District; and

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Trustees of the District that the Montana State Legislature is contemplating enacting a law that would lift the moratorium on creating new secondary districts, and

WHEREAS, the creation of new secondary districts which would be contiguous to Missoula County Public School Secondary District, would be detrimental to Missoula County Public Schools and it is believed Missoula County Public Schools could loose one of its urban high schools and experience a decline in students in the other two urban high schools; therefore:

BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Trustees of the Missoula County Public Schools, acting on behalf of the secondary district, believe there is wide spread public support for maintaining the three Missoula County Public Schools urban high schools; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Missoula County Public Schools' Board of Trustees request Montana State Representatives and Senators oppose the creation of new secondary districts in Missoula County.
