Fiscal Analysis

ASSUMPTIONS:

Office of Public Instruction (OPI)

1. If HB 660 is approved school districts will adjust their practices to meet the 30-hour notice requirement and avoid the payment of fees. There is no fiscal impact for OPI or to state support.

Board of Investments (BOI)

- The short-term investment pool does not assess a fee for withdrawal. The pool permits the investment and/or withdrawal of funds with 24-hour notice. If less notice is given the funds may not be withdrawn or invested until the day after they otherwise would.
- Local governments do invest in other types of investments for which an early withdrawal fee may be imposed.

EFFECT ON COUNTY OR OTHER LOCAL REVENUES OR EXPENDITURES:

The fee imposed on a district that fails to meet the 30-hour notice will be paid to the county and increase county revenues

TECHNICAL NOTES:

- HB 660 does not specify the fund to which the county will deposit the fees.
