1. Page 3.

**Following:** line 9

**Insert:** "(11) "Renewable energy credit" means a tradable certificate of proof of 1 megawatt hour of electricity from a qualifying renewable electricity generation source that is tracked and verified by the department and includes all of the environmental attributes associated with that 1 megawatt hour unit of electricity production."

**Renumber:** subsequent subsections

2. Page 5.

**Following:** line 13

**Insert:** "(5) In order to count as qualifying renewable electricity generation, the electricity must be accompanied by its associated renewable energy credits.

(6) Renewable energy credits from a qualifying renewable electricity generation source may be counted as qualifying renewable electricity generation even if the renewable energy credits have been purchased separately from the associated electricity from the qualifying renewable electricity generation source."

3. Page 6.

**Following:** line 8

**Insert:** "(4) Renewable energy credits from a qualifying renewable electricity generation source may be used to offset the environmental impacts disclosed in subsection (1) even if those credits have been purchased separately from the associated electricity from the qualifying renewable electricity generation source."

**Insert:** ", including the proper consideration and accounting of renewable energy credits"
