**Strike:** lines 20 through 23 in their entirety

Explanation - This amendment strikes the contingency language that required that both House Bill No. 102 and LC 1683 be passed and approved before allowing the approval of 1.00 FTE and general fund of \$754,995 in FY 2006 and 1.00 FTE and general fund of 754,813 in FY 2007 to support the Montana Drug Task Force. The language also allowed for the reduction of state special revenue of \$85,229 in FY 2006 and \$85,194 in FY 2007 and federal funds of \$612,796 in FY 2006 and \$612,848 in FY 2007.
