Explanation - This amendment increases state special revenue by \$1,050,000 each fiscal year of the 2007 biennium (\$2,100,000 over the biennium) to implement SB 98, the Montana Land Information Act. SB 98 provides funding for the geographic information system coordination function in the Information Technology Services Division of the Department of Administration. The amendment would provide state special revenue to fund existing 2.00 FTE that are currently funded through proprietary rates and \$810,000 grants to state, local, and tribal entities each fiscal year. Funding is from a \$1 per page increase in land transaction recording fees collected by county clerks and recorders. SB 98 has been passed and approved by the legislature and is on the Governor's desk for signature.
