Insert: "Human and Community Services Division includes \$50,000 in state special revenue in fiscal year 2006 and \$50,000 in state special revenue in fiscal year 2007 that are contingent upon passage and approval of House Bill No. 749 and Senate Bill No. 82. If House Bill No. 749 and Senate Bill No. 82 are not passed and approved, general fund money in Human and Community Services Division is increased by \$50,000 in fiscal year 2006 and by \$50,000 in fiscal year 2007."

Explanation - This amendment reduces general fund support for child care by \$100,000 for the biennium (\$50,000 per year) and increases state special revenue support from the prevention and stabilization fund by a like amount. Revenue to the Prevention and Stabilization Fund will increase if the Nursing Home (HB 749) and Intermediate Care Facility for Mentally Retarded (ICF/MR) (SB 82) utilization fees are increased as proposed.

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
