1. Page C-3, line 25.

Strike: "3,037,170 3,045,437" [state special fund FY06 and FY07]

Insert: "3,052,681 3,060,902" [state special fund FY06 and FY07]

2. Page C-6.

Following: "foundation." on line 3

Insert: "The department may provide the use of office space and office equipment for the fish, wildlife, and parks foundation staff. The department may fund operations and personal services of its own employees to act as liaisons with the fish, wildlife, and parks foundation for the sole purpose of representing the interest of the department."

Explanation - This amendment adds 0.25 FTE and \$15,511 in state special revenue in fiscal year 2006 and \$15,465 in state special revenue for fiscal year 2007, (\$30,976 total). This position would act as a foundation liaison and project coordinator. The funding is from the general license account.

This amendment also clarifies the restrictions of utilizing state special revenue for foundation activities.

1. Page C-12, line 3.

A positive motion on this amendment would authorize the legislative fiscal division to change the fund source from RIT excess corpus dollars to the reclamation and development account.

Explanation - This amendment provides authorization to switch funding from one state special revenue source to another. The current source is over appropriated. This funding is for the conservation and development division of the department of natural resources and conservation.
