InterMountain Planned Parenthood Outpatient Surgical Services Protocol for Minors

Minor: Patients age 15 years and under

1. These patient's can be scheduled for an US or Verification exam right away in order to determine if the patient is eligible for PPOPSS and to access scheduling.
2. After patient has had an US or Verification exam they can be scheduled into a clinic, however, patient will not be given a time for that clinic until the following criteria has been met.

Criteria:

One parent must be aware and talk with IMPPOPSS. (Document in progress notes)

Parent must accompany minor to clinic or parent must make other arrangements with clinic.
i.e. telephone conversation i.e. arrange for another adult person to come in with daughter

OR

If unable to tell parent minor must have another adult aware. Those who qualify as another adult would be as follows:

- aunt or sister over the age of 21, grandmother, friend's mother, boyfriends mother
- if none of the above, must be credible adult

These people if not a parent must be willing to accompany patient to clinic and be willing to take responsibility if complications were to occur and also co-sign the consent with the patient.

Boyfriend, no matter what age, does not qualify.

Refer any problems to clinic manager.
