RE: Conflicts between SB 205 (Shockley) and SB 493 (Laslovich) and SB 248 (Balyeat)

Please be advised that there is a conflict between these 3 bills as they all amend 61-6-304, MCA. All these bills deal with penalties for driving without mandatory liability insurance. A coordinating instruction has been prepared to coordinate SB 248 and SB 493. Sen Balyeat has agreed to a coordinating instruction that provides that if both SB 493 and SB 248 pass, SB 248 is void. **SB 248 should also be coordinated with SB 205.**

There remains a conflict between SB 205 (Shockley) and SB 493 (Laslovich). SB 493 strikes subsection (2) of 61-6-304 and SB 205 amends subsection (2). Subsection (2) deals with surrender of license plates to a court and registration suspension by the department. A policy decision has to be made before a coordinating instruction can be prepared. The policy decision is: Do you want to retain license plate surrender and registration suspension (as in SB 205) or delete it and replace with SB 493 penalties (as is done in SB 493). Once a decision is made on this issue, a coordinating instruction can be made as to how to coordinate the two bills. They can not both pass as currently drafted without an uncodifiable error.
