TO: Representative McAlpin and Senator Cromley
Members of the Senate Judiciary Committee

RE: Conflicts between **SB 67** (Cromley) (passed and sent to the Governor)
and **HB 476** (McAlpin)

DATE: March 22, 2005

Please be advised that there is a conflict between these 2 bills as both amend 25-1-201, 40-1-202, and 40-1-311, MCA. These bills increase the marriage license fee and the fee for filing of a declaration of marriage without solemnization. HB 476 increases the fees by \$13 and provides for the increase to go to the domestic violence intervention account. SB 67 (passed and transmitted to the Governor) increases the fees by \$10 and provides for the increase to go the county to fund district court operations. A coordinating instruction has been prepared to coordinate SB 67 and HB 476 to total the fee increase by \$23 to a total of \$53, with the increases going as planned by each bill.
