1. We would like road access thru private property.
2. We would like access to trail heads, hunting and fishing areas.
3. We would like mining claims to be accessible.
4. We would like the Fish Wildlife and Parks to give access to hunting, fishing and camping areas.
5. We would like to see the Forest Service do a better job of monitoring these areas than they have in the past 35 years.
6. There will be a demand for usage, as in the Bob Marshall Wilderness, by horses, packers, hunters, fisherman and bird watchers.
7. With the number of roads, lakes and creeks, parking and camping must be managed.
