Facts:

- 225 high school students taught on Thompson Falls campus
- 58 non-resident students attend high school on campus
- 7 therapeutic homes, whose students attend H.S. on campus
- 3 foreign exchange students
- 30 students from therapeutic homes attend H.S. on campus
- 8 additional students attend the district placed by Department of Public Health and Human Services
- 15 states plus Montana represented in therapeutic homes
- students from therapeutic homes have no lower GPA than resident students (end of the year)
- students from therapeutic homes score as well as resident students on state proficiency tests
- students from therapeutic homes have no more discipline problems than resident students
- students from therapeutic homes have been salutatorian, home coming queen, state champion in track, participants in school activities, featured soloists in concerts, student council members, national honor's society members, etc.
- almost all students from therapeutic homes attend post higher education and many at the University of Montana Higher Education Institutions
- public education is successful with Thompson Falls Therapeutic Students!
- therapeutic students at Thompson Falls High School are successful for Montana and our country!
