2. Page 3, line 14.

Strike: "1915"**Insert:** "1915(b)"

3. Page 7, line 2.

Following: "groups."**Insert:** "In adopting financial participation requirements for enrollees selecting coverage as provided in subsection (11)(b)(iv), the department may not adopt cost-sharing amounts that exceed the nominal deductible, coinsurance, copayment, or similar charges adopted by the department to apply to categorically or medically needy persons for a service pursuant to the state medicaid plan."

4. Page 8.

Following: line 2**Insert:** "(18) The department shall present a section 1115 waiver proposal to the house appropriations committee or the legislative finance committee prior to the submission of the proposal to the federal government for formal approval.

(19) The department shall provide for a public comment period on the proposed section 1115 waiver at least 60 days before the submission of the section 1115 waiver application to the federal government for formal approval. The department shall give notice of the proposal by announcing the pending submittal, stating its general purpose, and informing the public that a synopsis of the proposal is available on the department's website and shall provide for public comment through electronic means or mail. The department shall consider comments received and make any appropriate changes to the waiver request before submitting

it to the federal government."

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
