Insert: "(a) the term "contraceptive":

(i) means the use of any process, device, or method to prevent pregnancy, including steroidal, chemical, or barrier methods for preventing the union of an ovum with the spermatozoon or the subsequent implantation of the fertilized ovum in the uterus, including emergency contraceptives; and

(ii) does not include mifepristone or RU-486;"
