Following: line 14**Insert:** "(2) The Montana historical society, provided for in 22-3-101, shall make an inventory of the items that compose the official law enforcement officers' memorial repositied at the Montana law enforcement museum that was, until [the effective date of this act], located in the old Montana state prison, Deer Lodge, Montana. The inventory must:

- (a) determine the ownership of each item; and
- (b) include a description of and the condition of each item.

(3) The inventory conducted pursuant to subsection (2) becomes the official record of the items that on the date that the inventory was completed composed the official law enforcement officers' memorial.

(4) The director of the Montana historical society shall:

- (a) sign and date the inventory;
- (b) retain the original of the inventory at the state historical society; and
- (c) provide a copy of the inventory to the board of commissioners of Powell County.

(5) Nothing repositied at the official law enforcement officers' memorial may be removed until the inventory required in subsection (2) has been completed, evidenced by the signature of the director of the Montana historical society on the inventory."
