5	A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TRANSFERRING THE RAIL SERVICE COMPETITION COUNCIL
6	FROM THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR TO THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR
7	ADMINISTRATIVE PURPOSES; INCREASING DECREASING, MODIFYING, AND STAGGERING THE
8	MEMBERSHIP OF THE COUNCIL; EXPANDING THE DUTIES OF THE COUNCIL TO INCLUDE PROMOTING
9	THE EXPANSION OF EXISTING RAIL LINES AND THE CONSTRUCTION OF NEW RAIL LINES IN MONTANA;
10	PROVIDING AN APPROPRIATION; AND AMENDING SECTION 2-15-246, MCA."

12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
13	
14	Section 1. Section 2-15-246, MCA, is amended to read:
15	"2-15-246. Rail service competition council. (1) There is a rail service competition council consisting
16	of the following members:
17	(a) the director of the department of agriculture provided for in 2-15-3001;
18	(b) the director of the department of transportation provided for in 2-15-2501;
19	(c) the director of the department of revenue provided for in 2-15-1301;
20	(d) the chief business development officer of the office of economic development provided for in
21	2-15-218;
22	(C) THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE PROVIDED FOR IN 2-15-1301;
23	(D) THE CHIEF BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT OFFICER OF THE OFFICE OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PROVIDED FOR
24	<u>IN 2-15-218;</u>
25	(c)(c) six eight SEVEN people, appointed by the governor, who shall serve STAGGERED 4-year terms
26	commencing January 1 following their appointment, with the following qualifications:
27	(i) one person with substantial knowledge and experience related to Class I railroads;
28	(ii) one person with substantial knowledge and experience related to Class II railroads;
29	(iii) one person employed as a railroad employee of a railroad engaged in interstate commerce in the
30	state;



1	(iii)(iv)(III) one person who is a farm commodity producer in the state of Montana and who has substantial
2	knowledge and experience related to transportation of farm commodities;
3	(iv)(∨)(।∨) one person with substantial knowledge and experience in the trucking industry in the state of
4	Montana;
5	(v)(v)(v) one person with substantial knowledge and experience related to transportation for the mineral
6	industry in the state of Montana ; and
7	(vii)(vi) one person with substantial knowledge and experience related to transportation for the coal
8	industry in the state; and
9	(vi)(viii)(vII) one person with substantial knowledge and experience related to transportation for the wood
10	products industry in the state of Montana ; and
11	(f)(D)(F) two members, one from each political party and one from each house of the legislature, from
12	the economic affairs interim committee established in 5-5-223, selected by the presiding officer of the economic
13	affairs interim committee with the concurrence of the vice presiding officer at the first interim committee meeting
14	at the beginning of each interim.
15	(2) The rail service competition council shall perform the following duties:
16	(a) promote rail service competition in the state of Montana that results in reliable and adequate service
17	at reasonable rates;
18	(b) develop a comprehensive and coordinated plan to increase rail service competition in the state of
19	Montana;
20	(c) reevaluate the state's railroad taxation practices to ensure reasonable competition while minimizing
21	any transfer of tax burden. The reevaluation of the state's railroad taxation practices should include but is not
22	limited to a reevaluation of property taxes, taxes that minimize highway damage, special fuel taxes, and corporate
23	tax rates.
24	(d) develop various means to assist Montanans impacted by high rates and poor rail service;
25	(e) analyze the feasibility of developing legal structures to facilitate growth of producer transportation
26	investment cooperatives and rural transportation infrastructure authorities;
27	(f) provide advice and recommendations to the department of transportation on the department's
28	activities under 60-11-113 through 60-11-116;
29	(g) coordinate efforts and develop cooperative partnerships with other states and federal agencies to
30	promote rail service competition; and

1	(h) act as the state's liaison in working with Class I railroads to promote rail service competition; and
2	(i) promote the expansion of existing rail lines and the construction of new rail lines in the state.
3	(3) (A) The council shall cooperate with and report to any standing or interim legislative committee that
4	is assigned to study or has oversight duties for rail service competition issues.
5	(b) The council shall report to the 2009 legislature on its activities and its progress in
6	PERFORMING THE DUTIES REQUIRED IN SUBSECTION (2).
7	(4) The council must be compensated, reimbursed, and otherwise governed by the provisions of
8	2-15-122.
9	(5) The council is attached for administrative purposes only to the governor's office department of
10	transportation, which may assist the council by providing staff and budgetary, administrative, and clerical services
11	that the council or its presiding officer requests.
12	(6) Staffing and other resources may be provided to the council only from state and nonstate resources
13	donated to the council and from direct appropriations by each legislature."

15	NEW SECTION. SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION. THERE IS APPROPRIATED FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE
16	DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION THE FOLLOWING AMOUNTS TO SUPPORT THE RAIL SERVICE COMPETITION COUNCIL AND
17	ITS WORK:
