| 10 | Section 1. Section 23-7-402, MCA, is amended to read: |
| 11 | "23-7-402. Disposition of revenue. (1) A minimum of 45% of the money paid for tickets or chances |
| 12 | must be paid out as prize money. The prize money is statutorily appropriated, as provided in 17-7-502, to the |
| 13 | lottery. |
| 14 | (2) Commissions paid to lottery ticket or chance sales agents are not a state lottery operating expense. |
| 15 | (3) (a) That part of all gross revenue not used for the payment of prizes, commissions, and operating |
| 16 | expenses, together with the interest earned on the gross revenue while the gross revenue is in the enterprise |
| 17 | fund, is net revenue. |
| 18 | (b) Net revenue, except the amount attributable to unclaimed prizes, must be transferred quarterly from |
| 19 | the enterprise fund established by 23-7-401 to the state general fund. |
| 20 | (c) The amount of net revenue attributable to unclaimed prizes must be transferred quarterly to the |
| 21 | affordable housing revolving loan account established in 90-6-133. |
| 22 | (4) The spending authority of the lottery may be increased in accordance with this section upon review |
| 23 | and approval of a revised operation plan by the office of budget and program planning." |
