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9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
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11	Section 1. Section 2-2-111, MCA, is amended to read:
12	"2-2-111. Rules of conduct for legislators. (1) Proof of commission of any act enumerated in this
13	section <u>SUBSECTION (1)</u> is proof that the legislator committing the act has breached the legislator's public duty.
14	A legislator may not:
15	(1) (A) accept a fee, contingent fee, or any other compensation, except the official compensation provided
16	by statute, for promoting or opposing the passage of legislation;
17	(2)(B) seek other employment for the legislator or solicit a contract for the legislator's services by the use
18	of the office; or
19	(3)(C) accept employment with the state during the legislator's term of office; or
20	(3)(4)(D) accept a fee or other compensation, except as provided for in 5-2-302, from a Montana state
21	agency or a political subdivision of the state of Montana for speaking to the agency or political subdivision.
22	(2) For the purposes of subsection (1)(c), "accept employment" does not mean accepting a renewal
23	OR AN EXTENSION OF A STATE EMPLOYMENT CONTRACT."
