4	A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT REQUIRING A CRIMINAL BACKGROUND CHECK AS A PART OF
5	AN APPLICATION FOR A COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSE FOR THE PURPOSE OF TRANSPORTING
6	PASSENGERS; AND AMENDING SECTIONS 61-5-112 AND 69-11-201, MCA."
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8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
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10	Section 1. Section 61-5-112, MCA, is amended to read:
11	"61-5-112. Types and classes of commercial driver's licenses classification rulemaking
12	reciprocity agreements. (1) The department shall adopt rules that it considers necessary for the safety and
13	welfare of the traveling public governing the classification of commercial driver's licenses and related
14	endorsements and the examination of commercial driver's license applicants and renewal applicants. The rules
15	must:
16	(a) subject to the exceptions provided in this section, comport with the licensing standards and
17	requirements of 49 CFR, part 383, the medical qualifications of 49 CFR, part 391, and the security threat
18	assessment provisions of 49 CFR, part 1572;
19	(b) allow for the issuance of a type 2 (intrastate only) commercial driver's license in accordance with
20	medical qualification and visual acuity standards prescribed by the department;
21	(c) allow for the issuance of a type 2 commercial driver's license to a person who is 18 years of age or
22	older;
23	(d) allow for issuance of a seasonal commercial driver's license based on standards established by the
24	department for the waiver of the knowledge and road or skills test for a qualified person employed in farm-related
25	service industries who has a good driving record and sufficient prior driving experience;
26	(e) prescribe the operational and seasonal restrictions for a seasonal commercial driver's license;
27	(f) prescribe the requirements for the medical statement that must be submitted in order for a person to
28	be qualified for a type 2 commercial driver's license; and
29	(g) prescribe the minimum standards for certification of a third-party commercial driver testing program
30	and any test waiver under 61-5-118; and
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1	(h) provide for a criminal background check for all applicants for a commercial driver's license that is for
2	the purpose of transporting passengers.
3	(2) The department is authorized to enter into reciprocal agreements with adjacent states that would
4	allow certain drivers of vehicles transporting farm products, farm machinery, or farm supplies within 150 miles
5	of a farm to operate without a commercial driver's license because the vehicles are not considered commercial
6	motor vehicles as provided in 61-1-101(7)(b)(ii)."
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8	Section 2. Section 69-11-201, MCA, is amended to read:
9	"69-11-201. Requirements for carriers of persons for reward. (1) A carrier of persons for reward is
10	bound to shall provide vehicles safe and fit for the purposes to which they are put and is not excused for default
11	in this respect by any degree of care.
12	(2) A carrier of persons for reward must may not overcrowd or overload his a vehicle.
13	(3) A carrier of persons for reward must shall give to passengers all such accommodations as that are
14	usual and reasonable, must treat them with civility, and give them a reasonable degree of attention.
15	(4) A carrier of persons for reward must shall travel at a reasonable rate of speed, without any
16	unreasonable delay or deviation from his the carrier's proper route.
17	(5) A criminal background check is required for a carrier of persons for reward."
