6	ORDINANCE, OR REGULATION IS AN ABSOLUTE LIABILITY OFFENSE; ALLOWING A GOVERNING BODY
7	TO PROVIDE CIVIL PENALTIES; PROVIDING THAT EACH DAY OF VIOLATION CONSTITUTES A SEPARATE
8	VIOLATION; AMENDING SECTIONS 76-2-211 AND 76-2-315, MCA; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE
9	EFFECTIVE DATE."

11	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

13	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Violations and penalties. (1) A violation of this part or of a resolution
14	adopted pursuant to this part is a misdemeanor and is punishable by a fine of up to \$500 or by imprisonment in
15	the county jail for a term not exceeding 6 months, or both. The violation is an absolute liability offense as provided
16	for in 45-2-104.
17	(2) The governing body may also provide civil penalties not to exceed \$100 for a violation of this part or
18	of a resolution adopted pursuant to this part. Each day of violation constitutes a separate violation.

20	Section 2. Section 76-2-211, MCA, is amended to read:
21	<b>"76-2-211. Violations and penalties.</b> (1) A violation of this part or <del>any</del> of a resolution adopted pursuant
22	thereto to this part is a misdemeanor and shall be is punishable by a fine not exceeding of up to \$500 or by
23	imprisonment in the county jail for a term not exceeding 6 months, or both. The violation is an absolute liability
24	offense as provided for in 45-2-104.
25	(2) The governing body may also provide civil penalties not to exceed \$100 for a violation of this part or
26	of a resolution adopted pursuant to this part. Each day of the violation constitutes a separate violation."

28	Section 3. Section 76-2-315, MCA, is amended to read:
29	<b>"76-2-315. Violations and penalties.</b> (1) A violation of this part or of such an ordinance or regulation
30	made adopted pursuant to 76-2-308(1) is a misdemeanor, and such the city or town council or other legislative
