4	A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT EXEMPTING CERTAIN OWNERS OF PRIVATE FISH PONDS
5	FROM LICENSING REQUIREMENTS."

7	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

9	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Determination of licensing requirements for private ponds. (1) A person
10	who owns a private fish pond <u>WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE EASTERN MONTANA FISHING DISTRICT, AS ESTABLISHED</u>
11	BY COMMISSION REGULATIONS, and WHO wishes to stock the pond with game fish or other fish species from a
12	hatchery approved by the department may be exempt from fish pond licensing requirements and imposed duties
13	pursuant to 87-4-603(1) THROUGH (5) if:
14	(a) the pond does not come into contact with other bodies of water and it is outside an historic flood plain;
15	(b) there is no reasonable possibility of fish escaping and a threat is not posed to game fish or other fish
16	species in nearby waters;
17	(c) the pond does not exceed 50 acres in surface area; and
18	(d) the department has determined that the private pond is exempt from licensing requirements after
19	submission of a form AN APPLICATION described in subsection (2) AND AN ONSITE INSPECTION IF REQUESTED BY THE
20	DEPARTMENT PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (3).
21	(2) A person who owns a private fish pond <u>WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE EASTERN MONTANA FISHING</u>
22	DISTRICT, AS ESTABLISHED BY COMMISSION REGULATIONS, and WHO does not wish to obtain a private fish pond
23	license shall submit a department-generated form APPLICATION describing salient features of the pond, including
24	but not limited to the pond's size, location, and contact with other bodies of water-, AND APPROPRIATE WATER
25	RIGHTS.
26	(3) IF REQUESTED, THE POND OWNER SHALL PROVIDE ACCESS FOR AN ONSITE INSPECTION BY THE DEPARTMENT
27	PRIOR TO A DECISION BY THE DEPARTMENT AS TO WHETHER A LICENSING EXEMPTION WILL BE GRANTED.
28	(3)(4) If the department fails to issue a determination of whether the fish PRIVATE pond meets the criteria
29	for exemption from licensing requirements under 87-4-603 within 30 days OF RECEIPT OF A COMPLETE APPLICATION,
30	the owner of a private fish pond is considered to be exempt from licensing requirements.
