9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Appropriation. There is appropriated \$260,000 from the general fund to
12	the department of natural resources and conservation for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, for the purpose
13	of paying for a study to determine a revised cost allocation of the cost of Hungry Horse dam and associated
14	expenses to include flood control, hydropower generation, irrigation, and municipal and industrial water users in
15	the Clark Fork River basin in Montana. This cost allocation is a necessary step in the process by which the state
16	of Montana may contract for water in Hungry Horse reservoir to provide for additional water development and
17	protection of existing basin water rights.
