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9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
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11	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Protection of military personnel rulemaking authority. (1) The
12	commissioner may adopt rules relating to insurance transactions that may be necessary to protect military
13	personnel located or residing on a United States military installation in this state or located or residing elsewhere
14	in this state.
15	(2) The rules must be designed to protect the special needs of military personnel who are also insurance
16	consumers.
17	(3) Rules adopted by the commissioner may not go beyond the scope of any model regulations that are
18	adopted by the national association of insurance commissioners in response to a directive from the United States
19	congress in Public Law 109-290, directing that the states ensure implementation of appropriate standards to
20	protect military personnel from dishonest and predatory insurance sales practices.
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22	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an
23	integral part of Title 33, chapter 18, part 2, and the provisions of Title 33, chapter 18, part 2, apply to [section 1].
