4	A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT ALLOWING RETIRED MEMBERS OF STATE-ADMINISTERED
5	HIGHWAY PATROL OFFICERS' AND MUNICIPAL POLICE OFFICERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEMS TO HAVE
6	DUES PAYABLE TO CERTAIN ORGANIZATIONS WITHHELD FROM RETIREMENT BENEFITS AND PAID
7	DIRECTLY TO THE ORGANIZATION; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE AND
8	APPLICABILITY DATES."

10	WHEREAS, after retiring, many members of THE HIGHWAY PATROL OFFICERS' AND MUNICIPAL POLICE
11	OFFICERS' retirement systems administered by the Public Employees' Retirement Board want to continue as
12	dues-paying members of certain organizations through which the members can retain and enhance the ability
13	to improve the quality of their retirement; and
14	WHEREAS, many retired members of THE HIGHWAY PATROL OFFICERS' AND MUNICIPAL POLICE OFFICERS'
15	retirement systems administered by the Montana Public Employees' Retirement Administration (MPERA) want
16	$the\ option\ of\ having\ the\ MPERA\ automatically\ withhold\ dues\ payable\ to\ organizations\ of\ which\ they\ are\ members$
17	and automatically transfer the withheld dues to the organizations; and
18	WHEREAS, the stated mission of the MPERA is to efficiently provide quality benefits, education, and
19	service to help MPERA plan members and beneficiaries achieve a quality retirement.

21	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
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23	<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Section 1. Organization dues optional withholding payment rules. (1)
24	Subject to subsection (2), a A retired member who is a member of a qualified organization may elect annually
25	to have the board withhold dues payable to the qualified organization and transfer the withheld dues directly to
26	the qualified organization on behalf of the retired member.
27	(2) (a) Except as provided in subsection (2)(b), the annual election allowed under subsection (1):
28	(i) must allow the retired member to increase or decrease the amount of dues to be withheld and
29	<del>transferred;</del>
30	(ii) may be made by a retired member only once each calendar year or fiscal year pursuant to rules
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1	adopted by the board.
2	(b) A retired member may direct the board to cease withholding dues at any time. However, once the
3	board has ceased to withhold dues for the retired member, the retired member may not have the board withhold
4	and transfer dues for the remainder of the calendar year or fiscal year, as applicable. The retired member may
5	have the board withhold and transfer dues at any subsequent annual election for withholding and transferring
6	<del>dues.</del>
7	(3)(2) For the purposes of this section, "qualified organization" means a legal entity:
8	(a) that is formed, in part, for the benefit of the organization's members who are required or eligible to
9	participate in a single retirement system administered by the board; and
10	(b) whose active, inactive, and retired members participating in the single retirement system comprise
11	at least 50% of the active, inactive, and retired membership of the retirement system.
12	(4)(3) The board may adopt rules to implement the provisions of this section.
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14	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Codification instruction. (1) [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an
15	integral part of Title 19, chapter $\frac{2}{6}$ , part $\frac{9}{5}$ , and the provisions of Title 19, chapter $\frac{2}{6}$ , part $\frac{9}{5}$ , apply to [section
16	1].
17	(2) [SECTION 1] IS INTENDED TO BE CODIFIED AS AN INTEGRAL PART OF TITLE 19, CHAPTER 9, PART 8, AND THE
18	PROVISIONS OF TITLE 19, CHAPTER 9, PART 8, APPLY TO [SECTION 1].

20	NEW SECTION. Section 3. Effective date applicability. (1) [This act] is effective on passage and
21	approval July 1, 2007.
22	(2) [Section 1(1) through (3)] apply July 1, 2007.
23	(3) [Section 1(4)], [section 2], and this section apply on passage and approval.
