7	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

9	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Nongovernmental qualified or good faith immunity for alleged
10	constitutional violations. (1) To the extent that the courts of this state recognize a claim for violation of the
11	Montana constitution and except as provided in subsection (2), an individual defendant against whom a claim for
12	a violation of the Montana constitution is brought is entitled to the defense of qualified or good faith immunity in
13	the individual's alleged tortious conduct did not violate clearly established statutory or constitutional rights of which
14	a reasonable person would have known.
15	(2) This section does not apply to or affect the liability of the state or a political subdivision of the state
16	or counties, cities, towns, or other local government entities for allegedly violating the Montana constitution.

18	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an
19	integral part of Title 27, chapter 1, part 7, and the provisions of Title 27, chapter 1, part 7, apply to [section 1].
