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9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
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11	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Procurement rebate account funding use. (1) There is an account
12	in the state special revenue fund established by 17-2-102 to be known as the procurement rebate special revenue
13	account.
14	(2) All rebates collected <u>CREDITED TO THE DEPARTMENT</u> from using state procurement cards and contracts
15	must be deposited in the procurement rebate special revenue account.
16	(3) The money in the account may be used only to:
17	(a) administer the state's procurement card programs; and
18	(b) administer procurement-related activities, including procurement-related litigation, recycling of
19	electronics, and surplus property management. REIMBURSE APPLICABLE FUNDS TO THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT.
20	(4) The UNRESERVED, UNEXPENDED BALANCE OF THE FUNDS COLLECTED UNDER THIS SECTION MUST BE
21	DEPOSITED IN THE GENERAL FUND BY THE CLOSE OF THE FISCAL YEAR.
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23	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an
24	integral part of Title 18, chapter 4, part 2, and the provisions of Title 18, chapter 4, part 2, apply to [section 1].
