5	A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT REQUIRING THAT MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES'		
6	RETIREMENT BOARD APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR BE CONFIRMED BY THE SENATE; AMENDING		
7	SECTION 2-15-1009, MCA; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE AND AN APPLICABILITY		
8	DATE."

10	WHEREAS, the Public Employe	es' Retirement Board (PERE	3) administers and manages the assets of
11	10 separate retirement plans, with combined trust fund assets of over \$4.2 billion and benefit payments of over		
12	\$180 million to more than 18,000 retirees annually; and		
13	WHEREAS, the PERB has a fiduciary obligation to its paying members, retirees, and taxpayers to adopt		
14	and implement investment, administrative, and other policies that safeguard the interests of the members,		
15	retirees, and taxpayers; and		
16	WHEREAS, the Legislature has the obligation and authority to oversee and supervise those investment,		
17	administrative, and other policies; and		
18	WHEREAS, Montana statutes now require that the Governor submit to the Montana Senate for		
19	confirmation by the Senate the appointments to at least 65 various boards, committees, councils, and		
20	commissions; and		
21	WHEREAS, among the 65 entities for which Senate confirmation is now required are Title 37 licensing		
22	boards, such as the Board of Plumbers, and regulatory boards, such as the Board of Milk Control; and		
23	WHEREAS, the process of investigation and confirmation used by the Senate helps ensure that		
24	appointees to the 65 boards, committees, councils, and commissions are sincerely interested in the appointment,		
25	that they are responsive to the constituencies that they serve, and that they are legally and otherwise qualified		
26	for the appointment that they seek; and		
27	WHEREAS, the State Administration and Veterans' Affairs Interim Committee believes that the functions,		
28	responsibilities, and authority of the members of the PERB are at least equal to some of the other boards,		
29	committees, councils, and commissions for which Senate confirmation is now required; and		
30	THEREFORE, the State Admini	stration and Veterans' Affairs	s Interim Committee recommends that the

1	gubernatorial appointments to the PERB be made subject to confirmation by the Montana Senate.

3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:		
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5	Section 1. Section 2-15-1009, MCA, is amended to read:		
6	"2-15-1009. Public employees' retirement board terms allocation. (1) There is a public		
7	employees' retirement board.		
8	(2) The board consists of seven members appointed by the governor with the consent of the senate. The		
9	members are:		
10	(a) three public employees who are active members of a public retirement system (not more than one		
11	of these members may be an employee of the same department and at least one of these members must, no late		
12	than July 1, 2003, be a member of the defined contribution plan created pursuant to Title 19, chapter 3, part 21);		
13	(b) one retired public employee who is a member of the public employees' retirement system;		
14	(c) two members at large; and		
15	(d) one member who has experience in investment management, counseling, or financial planning or		
16	who has other similar experience.		
17	(3) The term of office for each member is 5 years.		
18	(4) The board is allocated to the department for administrative purposes only as prescribed in 2-15-121.		
19	The board shall hire necessary employees as provided in 19-2-404.		
20	(5) Members of the board must be compensated and receive travel expenses as provided for in		
21	2-15-124."

23	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Effective date. [This act] is effective on passage and approval.

25	NEW SECTION. Section 3. Applicability. [This act] applies to members of the public employees		
26	retirement board appointed after [the effective date of this act].
