7	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

9	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Violations standing to bring action against public agency. (1) The
10	denial by a public agency or association described in 2-3-203 of a citizen's right to observe and participate in the
11	actions and deliberations of the public agency constitutes an injury to the citizen. An allegation in a petition
12	brought under this part that the petitioner has been denied the right to observe and participate in a public agency's
13	decisionmaking is sufficient to establish standing to bring suit for the alleged violation.
14	(2) If a public agency or association described in 2-3-203 has geographical boundaries, the citizen must
15	be a resident within the geographical boundaries to have standing under subsection (1).
16	
17	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an
18	integral part of Title 2, chapter 3, part 2, and the provisions of Title 2, chapter 3, part 2, apply to [section 1].

20	NEW SECTION. Section 3. Effective date. [This act] is effective on passage and approval.
