13	WHEREAS, the future fisheries improvement program and the bull trout and cutthroat trout enhancement
14	program have proved to be effective voluntary programs to enhance Montana fisheries, including the historica
15	habitats of native fish; and
16	WHEREAS, private landowners and anglers have found both programs to be effective tools for increasing the effective for the effe
17	fish populations; and
18	WHEREAS, it is important to the future of Montana's native fish, fisheries, and anglers to make the future
19	fisheries improvement program and the bull trout and cutthroat trout enhancement program permanent.

21	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

23	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Repealer. Section 5, Chapter 463, Laws of 1995, and Sections 6 and 9
24	Chapter 529, Laws of 1999, are repealed.

26	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Effective date. [This act] is effective on passage and approval.
