5	A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT ALLOWING THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO
6	ENTER INTO AGREEMENTS WITH AGENCIES OF OTHER STATES TO ALLOW RECIPROCAL
7	REGISTRATION OF INTRASTATE AND INTERSTATE MOTOR CARRIERS, PRIVATE MOTOR CARRIERS,
8	AND FREIGHT FORWARDER AND BROKER INDUSTRIES; SPECIFYING USE OF CERTAIN FEES IMPOSED
9	ON MOTOR CARRIERS; AND AMENDING SECTION 61-3-708, MCA."

11	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

13	Section 1. Section 61-3-708, MCA, is amended to read:
14	"61-3-708. Cooperative or reciprocal registration filing of insurance fee. (1) The department
15	may enter into written agreements with agencies of other states to allow for the cooperative or reciprocal state
16	registration of intrastate, interstate, or international motor carriers, private motor carriers, and freight forwarder
17	and broker industries and may authorize the agency of a participating state to:
18	(a) issue interstate motor carrier registrations, stamps, and permits;
19	(b) accept filings of insurance, financial responsibility, and orders;
20	(c) collect and disburse fees;
21	(d) share and exchange information for audit, reporting, and enforcement purposes; and
22	(e) perform any other function that the department determines is justified to facilitate the cooperative or
23	reciprocal registration.
24	(2) (a) The department may impose a fee set by rule on an interstate or international motor carrier for
25	the administration of a motor carrier or freight forwarder or broker industry registered under an agreement entered
26	into as provided in this section. The fee must be paid on each motor vehicle, trailer, semitrailer, or pole trailer
27	operated by the motor carrier on the public highways of this state. At the time of initial registration and in each
28	succeeding year at a time set by the department, the motor carrier shall pay the fee to the department.
29	(b) The department shall remit the fee to the state treasurer for deposit in the general fund state special
30	revenue fund for use by the department for motor carrier safety assistance."
