8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10	Section 1. Section 2-15-3502, MCA, is amended to read:
11	"2-15-3502. Board of environmental review. (1) There is a board of environmental review.
12	(2) The board consists of seven members appointed by the governor. The members must be
13	representative of the geographic areas of the state. One member must have expertise or background in
14	hydrology. One member must have expertise or background in local government planning. One member must
15	have expertise or background in one of the environmental sciences. One member must have expertise or
16	background as a county health officer or as a medical doctor. In selecting the members, the governor shall
17	choose one member with expertise or background:
18	(a) in hydrology;
19	(b) in one of the environmental sciences;
20	(c) as a county health officer or as a medical doctor;
21	(d) in agriculture;
22	(e) in oil and gas development;
23	(f) in electrical energy generation; and
24	(g) in hard-rock or coal mining.
25	(3) A vacancy occurring on the board must be filled by the governor in the same manner and from the
26	same representative area as the original appointment.
27	(4) The board is designated as a quasi-judicial board for purposes of 2-15-124.
28	(5) The board is attached to the department of environmental quality for administrative purposes only
29	as provided in 2-15-121."
